
Do Not Be Deceived #deconstruction

the term to refer to another form of apostasy or departing from the faith, while others use it to describe the process of simply reassessing or rethinking one's faith.

#deconstruction

Deconstruction "encourages you to become the arbiter of what is true" and "the master of your faith," said Strachan. It denies the authority of God and his Word and promotes Self to the godlike task of curating your own personal religion

Deconstruction is a careful and deliberate examination of one's beliefs from the inside. It's about coming to terms with what you believe outside of your inherited beliefs. It's about growing INTO your faith, not out of it.
Sure, there are instances when one's spiritual journey may lead them away from the faith altogether. However, that is certainly not the goal. Deconstruction is a process of growth and maturation.
It is not necessary to throw the baby out with the bathwater as they say.
